I refer to representation received on 02/09/2009 on behalf of residents of De Selby & Belfry Estates in relation to provision of a pedestrian crossing at De Selby Estate on the Blessington Road.

The Senior Executive Engineer has reported that Dublin Bus have discontinued service at the bus stop outside the car dealers premises beside the Topaz garage, due to safety issues related to cars parked there. A meeting was held with Dublin Bus and the Gardai to resolve this problem. Additionally, discussions are being held with representatives from the Topaz garage in relation to the siting of the pedestrian crossing.

A decision is expected shortly and we are confident that a suitable location, for the pedestrian crossing, can be found.
