GRASS CUTTING

I have received numerous queries about overgrown grass along the main roads. My colleague Cllr Pamela Kearns has pursued this issue with the Council Management (please find on the reverse the recent response I received from the Council Management). In particular Pamela has been trying to ensure the grass in Templeogue Cemetary is cut in advance of this weekend's Cemetery Mass. The Parks Department have advised that the cemetery grass cutting will be completed by this weekend (July 11th).

WILLINGTON ROUNDABOUT

After extensive consultations between the Parks Department and Local residents associations, clearing and preparation work on the Willington roundabout will commence before the end of the month. It is envisaged that planting of shrubs will begin in early September.

At the last meeting of the WORK Residents Association plans of the proposed redevelopment of the roundabout were displayed. Due to budget cut backs the original plans had to be scaled back. If you would like copies of the plans please contact Cllr Pamela Kearns.

OSPREY BRIDGE

The Osprey Bridge was badly damaged by vandals at the end of May. The Council had given priority to repairing the bridge, but there had been a number of items that needed to be cleaned up after the repair works.
